2021 Rules and Prizes

18th Annual Marson & Marson Lumber Cascade Golf Classic

Speed of Play:

- Please keep play moving, especially if there is an open hole in front of you.
- For example, if you have a partner's shot on the green and know you cannot reasonably reach the green, skip that shot and get ready to make the putt.

Prizes:

- 1st, 2nd and 3rd lowest team scores. If there is a tie between teams for low score, the winner will be determined by using the #1 handicap hole, then the next, etc.
- Lowest scores will be determined considering handicaps.
- Longest Drive, Hole #13, for Men and Women: your drive must be in the fairway to count.
- Most Accurate Drive, Hole #8, for Men & Women (minimum 150 yards for men and 100 yards for women): this will be marked as a squiggly line.
- Closest to the Pin, Holes #5 & #15, for Men & Women: Two par 3s.

Rules:

- Today's golf competition will be a scramble format. All four members of the team will tee off on each hole (men

using White and women using Red). The team selects the drive they want to play, and all players will hit their next shot from a point one club length of the selected drive (not closer to the pin).

- All foursomes will use each player's drive at least TWO times during the round.
- Play continues in this format until one or more members of the team reaches the green. Select the ball to play, and all players will putt from within one inch of that selected spot, continuing until any player sinks the putt.
- If all four players' shots are in the water or out of bounds, advance to the most natural spot where the ball went in the water or out of bounds, and play from a spot within two club lengths of this selected spot where the ball was lost in the fairway. Ball in the water or ball out-of-bounds will be assessed a one-stroke penalty. **PLAY ON.**

Three Players or Fewer

- If you have only three players on your team, then each player will alternate holes hitting two balls, to make a total of four balls played on each hole.
- Teams with one or two players are excluded from the competition.

Mulligan Rules

- Only players that have purchased one or two activity packages are eligible to have a mulligan which gives that person an extra golf swing.

- They may be used on any shot (including putts) at the discretion of the player except for the tee shot on the “hole-in-one” holes. Also not for any shot at the gopher hole.
- Your mulligan can be used only if you have purchased an activity package and ONLY by the player possessing the mulligan and not the entire team.

Tossy Rules

- Each person that has purchased an activity package can use a tossy and must be used by that individual.
- The object of the tossy is to throw the ball to advance the ball to your advantage.
- It may be used on any shot. Here are a few suggestions on how it might be used: to put the ball in play from out of bounds; to get out of a sand trap; to get closer to the pin from off the green; to put the ball into play from a water hazard; to give you a better shot if you are behind a tree or have limbs in the way of your swing, etc.
- They may be used on any shot (including putts) at the discretion of the player except for the tee shot on the “hole-in-one” holes. Also not for any shot at the gopher hole.

Advantage holes # 9 and #18

- There will be an option of purchasing up to 2 advantage holes on the course, at holes #9 and #18. Instead of teeing off at the standard tee box, players will tee off at a designated spot beyond the original tee box.

- An advantage hole gives the team the chance to save a stroke or two on the two designated holes chosen on the course. Each person has the option of purchasing an advantage hole for \$5 per team member, or \$20 if one person chooses to buy it for the entire team.
- These advantage holes are designed for the entire team, so this is only allowed if the entire team decides to do it. Otherwise, the team tees off from the original tee box.

Gopher Hole #4

- The object of the Gopher Hole is for each player on the team to golf in the order that they are printed on the score card. The first player on the score card hits the tee shot. The second player hits the second shot. The third player hits the third shot, and the fourth player on the score card hits the fourth shot.
- After everyone has hit, the order starts again until the ball goes in the hole. This hole is not a scramble hole. This hole is played like you are playing by yourself, but each team member participates, and all rules of regular golf apply. When the hole is finished, the score needs to be recorded as a team score.
- Mulligans and tossies cannot be used on this hole.

Professional Golfers

PGA Professionals are welcome to play in the Cascade Golf Classic but, to keep the tournament as fair as possible, PGA Pros and their teams are ineligible to win any prizes.

General Information:

- Chipping, Putting and Driving Range Contests start at 9:30am
- All golfers meet at Putting Green at 10:40am for directions and rules from the pro
- **Shotgun start 11:00am**, courtesy of **Leavenworth Alp Horns**
- Restrooms inside front door of the clubhouse and on the golf course near tee boxes of hole #4, 9, 12 and 15.
- Silent auction and raffle – available all day. For auction, put your name and new bid on the item sheet to bid. Raffle ticket drawn wins prize. Announced at award ceremony.

Mystery wine

Available at the mystery wine table for \$20 all day long. All bottles are valued at more than \$20.

Pre-game contests

- Pre-game Chipping Contest: Men and women win a prize.
- Pre-game Putting Contest: Men and women win a prize.
- Pre-game Driving for Wine Contest: any ball hitting the island at 90 yards for women and at 145 yards for men wins a bottle of wine provided by **Eagle Creek Winery in Leavenworth**. \$5 for one ball, \$10 for 3 balls, \$15 for 5 (one bottle limit per golfer). Also, whoever hits the island the most times wins a 3L bottle of cabernet (a \$350 value).

During the game contests

Golfers can enjoy a free wine tasting at the tee box on hole #9, provided by **Milbrandt Vineyards in Leavenworth.**

- **Hole #13** – Longest Drive (Men & Women) wins a Prize
