The doors open at 6 p.m. for the concert — or arrive 30 minutes earlier and enjoy a spaghetti dinner catered by Me2You. Dinners are \$25 and must be pre-purchased by Sept. 13. Wine, provided by Plain Cellars, and other beverages will be available for purchase throughout the evening.

# Lab equipment campaign completed early

### Engine revving on next project — a vehicle for new MIH program

The new replacement hematology (blood) analyzer arrived at Cascade Medical's lab the first week in August, bringing, as promised, faster, more reliable blood count reports. It has the capacity to run up to 20 blood samples at once and eliminates the need to send out some specialized tests that take up to a week.

In addition to outstanding community support, the project's early completion was possible because the machine cost about \$20,000 less than the \$70,000 anticipated last fall. That gives us a head start on a second project — \$67,000 for a vehicle for Cascade Medical's startup Mobile Integrated Health program.

The MIH program will allow recently released hospital patients, the elderly and those with chronic conditions to receive in-home visits from Cascade Medical paramedics and EMTs. The check-ins will improve health outcomes and reduce hospital readmissions as patients



get help with medicine tracking, disease management and, if needed, access to telehealth services and other community support.

### More AEDs installed, ready to save lives

### Life-saving project will continue

Residents and visitors now have access to another eight potentially life-saving automatic external defibrillators (AEDs) in Leavenworth's downtown core. The Wi-Fi enabled AEDs, which analyze a heart's rhythm and, if necessary, deliver an OR electric shock to those experiencing sudden cardiac arrest, are easy to use, with instructions in English and Spanish.

The locations added in July include München Haus and Der Sportsmann, on Front Street, Gustav's on Highway 2, and two J5 Coffee locations. The new devices are part of a \$17,000 project by Cascade Medical and Cascade Medical Foundation, which included funding from a Leavenworth Lodging Tax Grant and community donations from last winter's Community Foundation of NCW's Give NCW online campaign.

This AED expansion project continues a \$40,000 effort in 2022 that delivered 21 new AEDs to schools, city offices and other public gathering spaces, replacing some older models and adding new locations. Cascade Medical Foundation

is hoping to continue to work with Cascade Medical to update and expand the availability of AEDs throughout the community.
