Endoscopy Suite Campaign more than halfway there

Community donations on track to surpass \$101,000 goal

Community support for Cascade Medical's Endoscopy Suite has been exceptional, with more than \$53,000 raised since November. At this pace, Cascade Medical Foundation expects to reach its \$101,000 goal this fall — and hopes to raise enough additional funds to add a much needed big wheel stretcher (\$23,100) to the project.

Endoscopies and colonoscopies play a vital role in early cancer detection and overall digestive health. For more than two decades, Cascade Medical has provided these essential services close to home, offering convenience and peace of mind for local residents.

To keep pace with growing needs and advancing technology, the Foundation's campaign will fund a new endoscope, two colonoscopes, an ultra-high-definition monitor and video system, and a stretcher — ensuring patients continue receiving top-tier care right here in our community.
