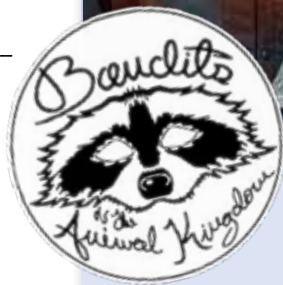

2025 Cascade Golf Classic sets record

Clinic bundle campaign is a wrap

An over-the-top successful charity golf tournament on June 16 put the bow on Cascade Medical Foundation's \$80,000 "Clinic Bundle" campaign, months ahead of expectations.

The 2025 Marson and Marson Cascade Golf Classic at Kahler Mountain Club raised \$52,000, setting a record for the 22nd annual event thanks to our generous sponsors, willing participants — and with the help and hard work of dedicated volunteers.

Event registration filled up several weeks in advance, setting another record that included a long waiting list! The lesson for next year: Register early! **Save the date: Monday, June 22, 2026.**

Since June, "Clinic Bundle" items have been ordered, including the bladder scanner, point-of-care ultrasound, specialty exam tables and chairs.

Board members also have identified the next fundraising goal: \$70,590 for a cardiac monitor for the Mobile Integrated Health Program. The plan is to complete this project by the end of the year.

Vital signs: Cardiac monitor in the works for Mobile Integrated Health vehicle

Cascade Medical Foundation's next fundraising campaign will purchase a cardiac monitor for the new Mobile Integrated Health (MIH) Program vehicle that rolled into action this year.

Cardiac monitors are routinely used on EMS and MIH patients to check heart rate and rhythm, blood pressure and pulse. The new device, estimated to cost \$70,590, also will offer telehealth options, ultrasound and video laryngoscope, all in one unit, further supporting the in-home services provided through the MIH Program.

MIH focuses on elderly patients and those with complex and/or chronic conditions. Services might include

post-hospital visits, high blood pressure monitoring, medication inventory, telehealth setups, health education and connection to other health services as needed.

Cascade Medical Foundation, with community support, helped gear up the program with the purchase of a Ford Explorer XLT late last year. As the home-visit schedule started to fill, the case for a cardiac monitor of its own became apparent.

EMS staff are constantly moving monitors between vehicles as patients are treated and transported. Purchasing a cardiac monitor for the MIH vehicle reduces the risk of not having a monitor when it's needed.



New AED stickers!

AED window stickers are now available to businesses and organizations hosting the life-saving devices.

Automated external defibrillators (AEDs) are used to analyze a heart's rhythm and, if necessary, deliver an electric shock to those experiencing sudden cardiac arrest.

Cascade Medical Foundation started creating a map of locations equipped with AEDs, including those we've purchased with community support, but we realized that in an emergency, it's faster to look for a window sticker.
