Smoother ride for endoscopy patients
Big-wheel stretcher added to fundraising project

A trip to the endoscopy suite may never be anyone's favorite experience, but thanks to generous community support, patients at Cascade Medical will soon enjoy a smoother ride.

Cascade Medical Foundation has added a **specialized big-wheel stretcher** to the list of equipment being purchased through this year's endoscopy suite campaign. Designed for safer, more comfortable patient transport, the stretcher's larger wheels reduce bumps and vibrations while making it easier for staff to maneuver between pre-op, procedure and recovery areas.

Along with the stretcher, campaign funds will purchase a new **endoscope**, **two colonoscopes**, and an **ultra-high-**

definition monitor and video system. Demand for endoscopic services continues to grow, with Cascade Medical recently adding a second procedure day to increase capacity and reduce wait times.

The \$23,100 addition raises the campaign goal to \$125,000. Strong community fundraising that started last November helped the Foundation reach its original \$101,000 goal sooner than expected.

The Foundation expects to complete the Endoscopy Suite Campaign this fall. Funds raised beyond the goal will go toward our 2027 campaign — a new mammogram machine. See details in our next newsletter!

Cardiac monitor
now in service

The cardiac monitor for Cascade Medical's Mobile Integrated Health (MIH) vehicle has been in use since June and is now a key part of every patient assessment conducted in the home by CM Medical Supervising Officers Jennifer Andrews and Erin Adams, who rotate MIH responsibilities.

Cascade Medical Foundation raised \$70,590 late last year to make this equipment a reality. Thank you to everyone who supported this project, completed with the help of a \$10,000 private donation and a \$2,500 grant from Confluence Heath/Wenatchee Valley Medical Group.
